The PILOT, the official organ of the Boston Archdiocese, recently asked why Premier Stalin resents plans for the free exchange of international news - and why he keeps a clause in the Soviet Constitution dealing with FREEDOM OF RELIGIOUS WORSHIP & FREEDOM OF ANTI-RELIGIOUS PROPAGANDA.

In other words, according to the Soviet Constitution, the people are allowed to worship God, but are denied the freedom of religious propaganda. Among other things, it means, no minister of the gospel may preach the word of God in any church, for that would be unconstitutional, for the Soviet Constitution permits only religious worship and not religious propa-
ganda. It does permit however, anti-religious propa-
ganda.

According to the Soviet Constitution, you can say what you want, print what you want - against God, against religion, against every thing that is sacred and holy, - not only with perfect immunity, but with Soviet sanction.

But it is treason against the Soviet State to preach the word of God in the house of God, - or to print the same.

And mind you, this Soviet State ranks as one of the BIG THREE, fighting for the principles of the Atlantic Charter, fighting for the freedom of peoples to express themselves and to choose their own form of governments and rulers.

What a farce. What a mockery. Oh, but it is unpatriotic to speak the truth, for the truth hurts - one of the BIG THREE, - for that is playing into Germany's hands.
