gelus. Well, the church bells are rung 3 times
every day - usually at 6 in the morning, at
noon and at 6 in the evening, at which time the
faithful are reminded to say the Angelus.

Now what is the Angelus? The angelus is a short prayer commemorating the annunciation of the birth of Christ to our Blessed Lady.

In brief it goes like this: The angel of the Lord, declare unto Mary; And she conceived of the Holy Ghost. This is followed by the prayer Hail Mary. Behold the handmaid of the Lord. Be it done unto me according to thy word. Again the Hail Mary is recited. And the Word was made Flesh and dwelt amongst us. A third time the Hail Mary is repeated. This is concluded with a short prayer.

The Angelus is usually offered up for the relief of the suffering souls in purgatory, who no longer can help themselves but depend on the mercy of God and the intercession of those left behind.

So as often as you hear the church bells ring in the morning, at noon and in the evening, remember it is a call to prayer.

And whether you are a Catholic or not; whether you know the Angelus or not; remember the Angelus bell is calling, reminding and asking you to think of God - if only for a few seconds.

May we suggest that you say in your heart - *Niech bedzie pochwalony Jezus Chrystus* - Praised by Jesus Christ, when the circumstances do not permit a longer prayer.

to annex, embraces 77,605 square miles, or 51.6% of Poland's territory. It is 100 times smaller than Russia's territory - but larger than the joint territories of THE NETHERLANDS, BELGIUM, DENMARK AND HUNGARY.

Its population numbers 13,199,000 or more than the ENTIRE POPULATION OF THE ARGENTINE REPUBLIC. Its area embraces 42% of Poland's arable land, - and 62% of Poland's pasturage land and meadows.

Did you know that the only woman of the invasion fleet, was a Pole? Among the thousands of sailors who took part in the invasion of Europe, there was it seems, only one woman - Jadwiga or Hedwig Pierzynski, a cook on a Polish merchantman.

The name Jadwiga or Hedwig in English, reminds us that there are some who do not know the English translation of Polish Christian names.

For instance - Stanislaw is STANISLAUS and not Stanley. Stas is a diminutive form of STANISLAUS.

Bronislaw is BRONISLAUS. BOLESLAW is BOLESLAUS, - and not Bernard, as some are incorrectly called.

Wladyslaw is LADISLAUS and not Walter. St. Ladislaus and St. Walter are 2 different saints.

By the way - and this is important and easy to remember - the accent in Polish is always on the same syllable, the penult, that is, on the next to last syllable - STANISLAW, BRONISLAW, BOLESLAW, WLADYSLAW, MIECZYSLAW.

And don't forget the LAUS in these names, does not rhyme with LOUSE but with LOSS.
