Appropos of the Fate of Warsaw - the last message sent by the Home Council of Ministers in Warsaw to Prime Minister Stanislaus Mikolajczyk on Oct. 3rd, reads: ~~All citizens of~~ All Polish citizens of Warsaw have been ordered by the Germans to leave the city immediately. The more than 240,000 Warsaw civilians herded into the Pruszkow concentration camp during the Battle of Warsaw, have been reported shipped to unknown destinations for unknown purposes. End of quote.

Did you know that Mexico opened its doors to some 1,500 Polish refugees, of whom 300 are orphans. To reach Mexico, these refugees have had to travel thousands of miles by land and water, thru Siberia, Iraq, Iran, India and the Pacific. And the only things that they did not lose during their long and trying trek, were their ~~pride and their faith~~ faith and their pride.

This Polish Colony of refugees is to be found at Santa Rosa Mexico.

For this information we are indebted to Eric Kelly, an American writer and educator, who in 1925 interrupted his professorship at Dartmouth, to go to Poland as a scholar of the Kosciuszko Foundation.

During a year of study and lecturing, at the U of Krakow, Mr. Kelly grew to love Poland and the Polish people - and gave expression to his devotion to Poland by writing many books on Polish themes.

His work, THE TRUMPETER OF KRAKOW, won for Mr. Kelly the JOHN NEWBERRY MEDAL in 1928 "quote: for the most distinguished contribution to American literature for children."

His story about Copernicus, the eminently great Polish astronomer, FROM STAR TO STAR has just been published.
