Dear Staś,



It came over beautifully, and your voice... like Aloysius Havrila, or Jimmie Wallington, or, John Patrick Costello... or... you know that voice that gets 'em... every time one of 'em sighs... they lose themselves in a swoon... and shorten their lives by a day. The recordings came over perfectly. Don't remember 'em all... some: "Nie mów" -- "Gdy ta melodia gra", "Tysiąc Walcznych" etc. Your facts about the Poles very interesting and informative. They were familiar to me, because during my stay at the Catholic Univ., in Washington I spent many hours in research for statistics on early Poles data. Maybe I have some that you have not, come up and see me some time... I mean me not Mae West...

One of our Polish priests died. Rev. Ant. Pinciurek of Schenectady 63 yrs. of age. Was sick only a day and a half.
