The first rector of the Wilno University, was the famous orator and writer Piotr Skarga - and its professorial body included the first translator of the bible, Jacob Wujek.

Adam Mickiewicz, Poland's greatest poet, author of Pan Tadeusz, was born in Wilno and a product of Wilno University.
