2 Enemy Warships Wrecked, British Craft Hit Off Ushant

LONDON, June 9—In the first naval engagement of any moment since invasion day, a force of British, Canadian and Polish warships intercepted four German destroyers about ten miles southwest of Ushant, off the Brittany peninsula, early this morning, and when the smoke of battle cleared, one enemy craft had been blown apart, another left in flames on the beach and the other two escaped after receiving damaging hits.
